Your Support At Home budget can be used on an extensive range of services tailored to your care plans, goals and preferences.

Support At Home is a government-funded initiative that supports individuals aged 65 and older in maintaining their independence at home. Once funding is assigned, you can engage Benetas to create a personalised care plan tailored to your needs, and to deliver your services with quarterly budget and care reviews.

You may need to contribute to the cost of your Support At Home services. Based on your means and asset test, Services Australia will advise your co-contribution. Call Services Australia to learn more.

Our aim is to assist you in staying at home as long as possible. Your Care Partner can provide a price on a comprehensive range of services identified within your unique care plan. Many of these costs can vary depending on the services, and require My Aged Care approval.

**Assistive Technology and Home Modifications (AT-HM)**

Funding up to \$15,390.00 per assessed need

AT-HM is a separate scheme to provide funding for equipment and home modifications, with three funding tiers - low, medium and high depending on assessed needs.

**Restorative Care Pathway**

This short-term support is designed to help participants regain strength and delay the need for ongoing services. It extends the previous 8-week program to up to 16 weeks, offering funding of up to \$6,000 per episode, with higher amounts available for those with more complex needs.

**End-Of-Life Pathway**

For those wishing to stay at home in their final months, this pathway provides intensive support over a 12-week period. A one-off budget of \$25,000 is available for eligible participants through the End-of-Life Pathway.

If you receive services via Community Health, HACC-PYP, VHC or CHSP, the Government asks you to make a personal co-contribution to your services.

For Community Health, HACC-PYP or CHSP services, your personal co-contribution will be based on either your income or your concession card status. As per Government guidelines you will be required to declare your income to determine which co-contribution rate you will be charged. Please note:

- The Schedule of Fees is developed as per the principles provided by the Government;
- All services and products are arranged and approved in consultation with yourself and your clinician and are based on your assessed needs and established goals within your care plan;
- Additional costs may apply for products, this will be in consultation with you;
- If cancellation notification is not received 24 hours prior, a service charge will apply. If repeat cancellations occur, your services may be cancelled;
- Funding cannot cover services or products funded by another source such as Support at Home classification, VHC, TAC, Medicare, Private Health Insurance or NDIS;
- If you are receiving services through Macedon Ranges Health, payment is to be made over the counter after your visit. If you receive home visits you will receive a monthly invoice. Our preferred method of payment is Direct Debit for invoices and electronic payment on the day for centre-based visits.
- A flat rate per visit applies to CHSP nursing for low and medium income ranges. If you are in the high income range, you are charged per hour. In these instances, minimum visit time charged is 30 minutes.

Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP) client contribution fees

Benetas offers CHSP services to eligible clients (must be registered with My Aged Care and have the service referral allocated by MAC which comes in the form of a referral code) in Hepburn Shire, Southern Metropolitan Melbourne, Eastern Metropolitan Melbourne, Western Metropolitan Melbourne, Northern Metropolitan Melbourne, Gippsland and Macedon Ranges.

Co-Payment Amount and Caps

Entitled persons contribute to the cost of the VHC Services by paying a small co-payment, which is capped at a maximum amount. The following co-contribution amounts and caps apply:

There are many benefits to funding your own home care. You can access an extensive range of services tailored to your needs and preferences. You get the benefit of a Care Partner or Care Coordinator overseeing your care plan and services without the administration burden from receiving government funding. If you are eligible for government funding, but have not yet been granted Support at Home, you can pay privately for services until your classification is ready, which provides the relief you need to continue living comfortably and safely at home.

Our friendly staff can provide all or some of your services, so you have the flexibility of choosing other suppliers to meet your varying preferences. The below fees also apply if you choose to top-up your assigned Support at Home services privately. Please note fees are reviewed annually and are subject to change. If you have a contract through another provider your provider will be charged our Private Rate.



Transport

We can provide transport to and from shopping, appointments or social activities.
\$1.40 per km fee in addition to the rates below



Shopping

We can support you with grocery and other types of shopping (we can accompany you, or shop for you).

Nurses time is billed at 30 minute, 1 hour and then 15 minute increments thereafter. Some nursing services provided by IHNS require a signed and dated authorisation letter from a GP or other medical practitioner prior to commencement of services. The GP Authority will be requested during the referral process. Should the IHNS Team be required to obtain this, an administration fee of \$100.00 will be charged.
