Upper and Lower design

Along with more traditional style, single-level units, St John's Rise will use an innovative 'Upper and Lower' design approach to ensure greater independence for longer with single-level homes. This approach benefits both the over and the under units; the over units reap the benefits of a sunny balcony with a sprawling outlook of the native landscape, and the under units have a private and easy to maintain courtyard, perfect for entertaining.

The Lower units face onto a row of Upper units, as is depicted in the image below, this maintains the sense of community and neighbourhood while ensuring each unit has its own privacy.

Location

St John's Rise is in the heart of Mooroolbark, with breathtaking native landscapes in harmony with the convenience of suburban Melbourne.

Located on Reay Road in Mooroolbark, St John's Rise is situated in the ideal location to provide the best of both worlds. Escape into your own community, with landscaped paths and an abundance of native flora.

This peaceful location not only allows you to fully enjoy your own serene environment, but also ensures that you are close to the local community, shops and services. St John's Rise is only 40 minutes to Melbourne's CBD if you are seeking the excitement of the big city.

The track runs from Kilsyth to Croydon and provides locals with a serene walking trail surrounded by native bushland. There are also many reserves in Mooroolbark and surrounding areas, with the Larnook, Orrong and Greenslopes Reserves in walking distance from the village.
